



## TOC/VBRA - REFEREE COACH RE-ACCREDITATION

To retain their accreditation, all Referee Coaches must be registered, financial and active.

All currently registered, financial, qualified Referee Coaches will be considered accredited for 2017, provided you satisfactorily completed the test this year.

### • Referee Coach Accreditation is a One-Year Program

- In 2017 you will be accumulating points towards your accreditation in 2018. This can be done in a variety of ways as detailed in the document detailing the system
- You must be a financial and registered member of a TOC/VBRA branch to collect points towards your reaccreditation. Metro membership fees are due on/before March 31<sup>st</sup> each year.
- BVC registrations will be collected by the Country Commission system and forwarded to the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer.
- The annual Theory test must be completed each year (commencing with **this year's** online exam)

• Advisors: To claim Advisor exemption, they must satisfactorily complete the Annual Theory Test + attend at least 2 Advisor Meetings per yr. (commencing with **this year's** online exam)

• League Referee Coaches: To claim League Referee Coach exemption, they must satisfactorily complete the Annual Theory Test (commencing with **this year's** online exam) + receive a recommendation from the League Appointment Officer indicating, a satisfactory performance in League related activities.

### **FAQs:**

#### **Do Grade 1 referee coaches need to be reaccredited using this system ?**

- Yes. They are appointed/accredited/reaccredited at a local level by Advisors (or the Country RDO in regional areas). Advisors will be asked to forward details of locally accredited Grade 1 referee Coaches to the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer, at the time of registration each year (March 31<sup>st</sup>)

#### **Who keeps a record of my points (Grade 2, 3 and 4) ?**

- For completeness, you are advised keep a record of any game observations/assessments you complete at a domestic level.
- Your branch Advisor should advise the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer of your activity in this area.
- You will need to ask your Advisor to indicate to the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer when you are involved in a mentor role, so this can be included in your file.
- If you attend an official TOC/VBRA event (Advisor, Referee Coach meeting, Rules Session, League Information Session etc.), and sign the attendance sheet, your points will automatically be added to your file.
- We will automatically add points to your file from League appointment rosters
- We will automatically add points to your file from International/National appointments

#### **Will I be advised when I have reached the required number of points ?**

- Yes – we will advise you via email.

#### **I am going overseas or am injured – can I get an exemption ?**

- Yes – contact the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer at the State Basketball Centre and advise them of your situation.

#### **What if I upgrade my Referee Coach qualifications during the year ?**

- You will be accredited for the balance of that year as well as the following year. During the following year, you will be accumulating points towards our accreditation for the subsequent year (etc)

#### **I want to remain accredited but I don't get games to evaluate/coach in my association ?**

- We would hope that Advisors make use of the referee coaches in their associations but in the end, it is their decision as to who they appoint to do game evaluations/assessments. If this is an issue for you, please contact the TOC/VBRA Admin Officer at the State Basketball Centre and advise them of your situation.
